

Where Western Works

Western Electric Company, manufacturing and supply unit of the Bell System, has been serving the country's communications since the last century. It conducts manufacturing operations at 15 major plants and their tributary shops. The Company also maintains 35 distribution centers which stock equipment and supplies, 34 of which also repair service-worn apparatus for Bell telephone companies. Western Electric installers work in 25 areas to handle the job of installing telephone central office equipment. Both installation and distribution, as well as systems equipment engineering, are parts of the Company's Service Division, which has eight regional offices. On July 1, 1967, there were 103,250 employees in the Manufacturing Division, and 55,711 in the Service Division. These, plus employees in the Defense Activities Division, and administrative staffs at corporate headquarters in New York, totaled 164,734. H-174
